## Indoor Memorial Ideas

### ■ Create a Memory Shelf

Display a favorite photograph, collar, tag, paw print, toy, memorial candle, or small urn.

## Seasonal Remembrance Traditions

## Understanding Aftercare Options

### Private Cremation

Your pet is cremated individually and ashes are returned.

### Communal Cremation

Multiple pets are cremated together and ashes are not returned.

### Burial

May include home burial (where permitted), pet cemetery, or family property. Always check local regulations first.

- Memorial sculptures
- High-end commissioned artwork
- Custom jewelry collections
